

ENDERBY MEMORIAL ARENA

Ice Puppy 1

This small class is for children who have little or no prior skating experience, but are ready to participant in a class without a parent. Learning balance, safety and forward movement is the focus of this level. (skill focus: standing and walking)

Ice Puppy 2 This small class is for children who can stand up from a seated position and can take 5 to 10 forward walking steps confidently without assistance or falling. (skill focus: walking to glide)

Super Skater 1 School aged children with little or no previous skating experience. Skaters will learn how to glide and push with weight transfer and good balance, progressions for stopping and skating backwards will also be worked on.

Super Skater 2 School aged children with previous skating experience will learn basic stopping, backwards skating and edge control.

Participants are required to wear PROPERLY fitted CSA approved helmets, gloves or mittens, and warm comfortable clothing during lessons.

LARCH HILLS

When the snow falls and the ice forms, we grab our preferred winter gear and enjoy every second of it! Cross-country skiing and snowshoeing are popular activities along our many area trails. There are over 41 kilometres of track-set trails and over 98 kilometres of adjacent non-track-set trails at Larch Hills north-west of Enderby. This winter wonderland also includes a varierty of marked snow-shoe trails a heated chalet, and lots of Larch Hills Nordic Soceity members readt to point out the best trails.

KINGFISHER INTERPRETIVE CENTRE

Explore the snow covered beauty of rural Enderby with a day of snowshoeing at the Kingfisher Interpretive Centre.



HUNTERS RANGE

Carve it up this winter on the rolling hills of Hunter Range where snowmobilers of all abilities will find spectacular riding terrain. Go steep and deep on challenging hills and bowls, while enjoying some of the driest powder you can find! The Hunters Range Snowmobile Association maintains over 90 kilometres of groomed trails and several chalets where sledders can warm up for the next run. The 300 member group hosts several events throughout the season including the Poker Rally in January and a ladies ride in March. The group

monitors access points to Hunters Range and charges a fee to non-members.


