REPORTS

Councillor Baird

- Met with an individual who is willing to work on developing the “app” for the Cliff Crunch and other local trails.
- Garbage accumulation at the pull-out at the north end of town continues to be a problem. Installation of a dumpster downtown? Removing the garbage receptacle is also an option.

It was the consensus of Council to support the removal of the garbage bin at the pull-out at north end of the City.

- Recycling bin is required at Riverside Park.
- No Dogs signs are on order for Tuey Park.

Councillor Shishido

- RDNO will be doing a ridership analysis to determine if it is feasible to increase Salmon Arm route.
- Chief Administrative Officer created a community calendar free of charge to be used by the City and Chamber of Commerce. Both websites have access to the calendar which resolved the issues of who controls the calendar. Each has control from their own website and the public sees it as one calendar. A Council calendar would have back-end access.

Councillor Davyduke

- Encouraging to see more women from Enderby involved with “Empowering Women in Business”.

Councillor Schreiner

- Paving was done on Kildonan Avenue.

- Same Directors were selected at the Resource Centre annual general meeting.
- FSCT – “Harvest Hut” signs are going up soon. Drop-off and pick-up are on Mondays 9am – noon. The Harvest Hut is accessible to anyone, not just the needy. It is hoped that surplus garden produce will be donated and folks ‘trade’ for something they didn’t plant in their own garden. They are keeping track of the number of pounds of food that is given out to aid in future grant applications. Next meeting is 9:30 am July 27th at the Harvest Hut.
