
RAISED INTERSECTION A raised intersection at Cliff Avenue and Belvedere Street enhances pedestrian safety and facilitates community activities. This intersection plaza, level with the adjacent sidewalks, is completely driveable but feels like an extension of the pedestrian area in front of the public library. This flexible space can be closed to traffic for street markets, musical performances, community dinners, or festivals.

LIGHT COLUMNS Smaller versions of the dramatic gateway light columns frame the intersection plaza, lending a festive and unique feel. Like the gateway light columns, these steel columns suggest river or forest industry in the daytime, and become sparkling light features at night.

SPECIAL SEATING Custom seating, suggestive of river rocks or summer river floating, adds a playful element to the streetscape, making downtown Enderby unique yet comfortable. To accommodate people of varying needs and abilities, standard benches will also be included along Cliff Avenue, along with trash receptacles and bicycle racks.

RAIN GARDENS Planting areas soften and beautify the street while doing double duty as rain gardens. Roadway storm water is directed into these rock beds which are planted with tough perennials, grasses, and sedges that can tolerate both dry and wet conditions.
