- School breakfasts are tomorrow and Wednesday.
- Judged best Christmas light display. Winners were from Birch Crescent, Salmon Arm Drive, and Polson Avenue.
- Attended Christmas dinner with Splatsin.
- Participated in Regional Library meetings.

Councillor Shishido

Chamber of Commerce:

- It has been a challenge to find skating instructors for recreation programs.
- Since September there are over 1,000 fitness customers.
- Arena has new accessibility equipment.
- There will be a ball user group meeting in February.
- Batting cage is a potential project for this spring.
- The RV Park took in \$7,000 more in camp fees this year.
- 7 trees have been removed.

- Manager is still dealing with the unsightly camp sites.
- Business Excellence Awards – entertainment and venue have been secured. They need more nominations.
- Shuswap Tourism contract is expiring.
- Upgrades to RV Park – coin showers and new sewer service lines will be going in.
