DELEGATIONS

Salmon Arm Councillor Tim Lavery and Director at Large for SILGA Re: SILGA Convention

Mr. Lavery provided a brief overview of what the function of the Southern Interior Local Government Association (SILGA). Each fall there are educational opportunities for elected officials.

2017 initiatives included the prevention of the spread of invasive mussels, the issue of the attraction and retention of physicians, and youth involvement at UBCM.

2018 will focus on housing challenges, infrastructure issues, and legislation on the legalization of marihuana.

Mr Lavery concluded by extending an invitation to the annual convention taking place in Revelstoke in April.
