## PORTFOLIO REPORTS

#### Councillor Case

Attended the Museum's AGM and did a presentation about the Rail Trail. Brad Clement spoke about the stretch of trail to Kelowna.

#### Councillor Knust

Low Income Housing - It is difficult to get an accurate inventory of what is out there and available.

FACT – the old HUT will be moving.

#### Councillor Schreiner

Attended an Okanagan Film Commission meeting.

Opiod Crisis – Apparently there are drug test strips that indicate if drugs are safe. These should be readily available as part of harm reduction.

Visited the walking trail in Keremeos and took pictures of their lighting.

Has received complaints about an unsightly property on Belvedere Street. The CAO asked Councillor Schreiner to advise the complainant file a complaint so that bylaw enforcement can follow up.

#### Councillor Baird

The Okanagan Regional Library not yet hired a new administrator.

Six new spray park features have been ordered. They are scheduled to be installed before the May long weekend.

Reminder – Dairy farm tour is April 5<sup>th</sup>.

#### Councillor Shishido

Chamber of Commerce:

- RV Park dealing with some issues.
- New tables needed. Also, quotes being obtained for tree replacement.
- The park manager has presented suggestions for events at the park Airstream trailers; classic cars/motorhomes; Caribbean day festival.
- May 10<sup>th</sup> ball tournament taking place.
- They have funds available in their budget to hire an assistant for the campground manager.
- \$5,000 has been budgeted for website design. No responses to the RFP.
- Camping fees are up 130% compared to the same time last year.

Enderby and District Arts Council – Attended their AGM. A new budget is being drafted due the loss of \$5,000 performance grant funding.
