- .4 Provide, maintain and remove on completion, barriers, hoardings and warning safety signs in work areas and for the protection of work people.

 - .5 Compatible mastic shall be applied to the base of all appliances. That may be in the areas where S.B.S membranes are installed.
 - .6 Provide maintain and remove upon completion, barriers, signage, and hoardings in work areas used for the protection of Owner's employees and public during installation procedures.







PAYMENT SCHEDULE FOR ENDERBY CITY HALL

The draws for re-roofing shall be based on the following criteria

A 10 percent hold back on each segment till completion of project.

Verification of payment of labour, written verification is acceptable.

Final payment shall be released upon notarized verification of all disbursements.

Hold back shall be for a period of 60 days from receipt of notarized statement indicating all bills have been payed . The final payment shall be held in trust until all documentation has been completed and any deficiencies have been dealt with to the satisfaction of the Owner and or owner's representatives.

First request for draw may be submitted upon commencement of project and loading of materials.

First draw not to exceed 30% of total project value.

Subsequent draws shall be based on completion of roof assembly and rectifying any deficiencies prior to the submission of invoice.
