PETITIONS AND DELEGATION

Okanagan Regional Library (ORL): Don Nettleton, CEO

Fall 2019 Library Update:

- ORL serves a population of 400,000 people, 31 locations and is governed by a 24-member Board.
- 157, 601 patrons attended ORL programs and used Library meeting spaces.
- Overview of Library programs available for adults and children, Digital Literacy and Maker Spaces.
- Reviewed current overall budget of just over 19 million per annum, budget changes, effects of Provincial funding freeze and expenses.
- Currently has 266 Employees including 152 part time and 59 full time.

Dawn Wierzbicki, Community Librarian

- Gave an update on the Enderby Branch.
- 3300-3500 people have been through the Enderby Library doors this month.

- All programs being offered are community based.
- Some local programs being offered are the Dyslexia Think Tank, OWL Presentation, Solar Energy, Hatch-a-Chick Program, Local Author Meet and Greet, Coding Through Play, Interagency Meetings, Annual Early Years Fair and the Gingerbread Competition.
- Appreciate all of Councils support and time. Council noted that the community is very supportive of the programming being offered by the Library and it is a huge asset to the community.
