



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF ENDERBY

Decision Summary of a **Regular Meeting** of Council held on Monday, May 4, 2020 at 4:30 p.m. by teleconference.

1. Council approved keeping the property tax due date at July 2nd but deferring the penalty date to October 1, 2020.
2. Council approved waiving the penalty for the January-April utility billing period.
3. Following a consideration of written representations from the public, Council adopted its budget bylaws which amount to a 0.4% decrease in the City's property taxes and user fees (note that the City also collects property taxes for other entities, like hospitals and schools, which determine their tax rates independently of the City).
4. Council adopted a Revenue Anticipation Borrowing Bylaw to provide borrowing authority to maintain cashflows necessary for the City's ongoing operations and paying the taxes that it collects for other government agencies.
5. Council decided to send a letter to the Minister of Environment and Climate Change Strategy in support of an early and well-managed resumption of local access to provincial parks to support the health and well-being of residents.
6. Council endorsed principles for corporate service recovery.
7. A Pandemic Community Recovery Select Committee was created to address individual and business recovery and resiliency.
8. Council reviewed the Enderby Child Care Action Plan and adopted the implementation actions, including an amendment to the City's zoning bylaw and an advocacy letter to the Province in support of the child care sector.
9. At a future meeting, Council will be considering a recommendation from its Economic Development Portfolio on three appointees to the Board of Variance.
10. Council referred correspondence from the Chamber of Commerce on business recovery to its Pandemic Community Recovery Select Committee.
