Mayor and Council Reports

Councillor Schreiner

- Attended the Regional Growth Strategy meeting at the Regional District of North Okanagan.
- Will be attending a Regional Housing Strategy meeting this week.
- Noted that it has been good to see all the local housing development applications.
- COVID Safe Restart Grant funding for Fortune Parks has been approved by RDNO.

- Asked Staff whether there have been any updates on Telus Fiber Optic installation in Enderby. The Chief Administrative Officer informed Council that we have not heard any news from Telus but have been advised that Shaw is offering fibre internet service in Enderby.

Councillor Case

- Bob Cowan delivered a journal written by the City Works Manager in the 1930's. Very interesting perspective from that era. His only equipment was a shovel. There was a year when City Staff did not make a salary as they could not afford to pay them and 1/3 of all properties were sold for unpaid taxes.

Councillor Shishido

- Neil Fidler, Enderby and District Arts Council, submitted an Arts Council update that is included on the regular agenda.
- Community Arts Centre fundraising initiative:
 - o Collection boxes set out.
 - o Raffle for e-bike.
 - Bottle drives ongoing.
 - Donation of art/books.
- Enderby and District Community Resource Centre meeting February 9, 2021. Doris Shipmaker donated her car to a family in need.
- United Way Organization amalgamating local branches.
- Flower Basket Sale (\$40.00 each) through Enderby & District Community Resource Centre.

Councillor Knust

- Interagency Zoom meeting. Councillor Knust continues to experience limited internet connectivity from her home location.
- The Enderby Pre-School was not open for the last year. This decision was made to allow for a higher capacity of daycare children.

Councillor Davyduke entered the meeting (4:17 p.m.)

Councillor Knust spoke with the Principal at M.V. Beattie Elementary, Gene Doray, and discussed COVID-19 absences. Numbers have returned to normal but at one point there were 145 students at home due to the pandemic. Dog feces have become a problem in the elementary school field. They are looking for assistance in controlling the issue. Staff have been in discussions with Principal Doray and will be moving the doggie bag dispenser from Sicamous Street to the beginning of the trail at the school, once weather permits. Hopefully this will encourage proper disposal, although there are ongoing problems with irresponsible dog owners regardless of whether bag dispensers are nearby.

Community Futures Update:

- There have been 22 applicants for the Enterprize Challenge including representation from Enderby.
- Finalists Pitch, Awards & Challenger Showcase April 28, Live stream from the Vernon & District Performing Arts Center.

- Have been receiving a lot of inquiries about the Wage Subsidy Program. Funding still available.
- 37 businesses in the Women in Business Accelerator Program. Intake in the Spring/Fall.
- Moving towards a virtual platform for 2021.
