City of Enderby Flood Mapping and Risk Assessment Report

Presentation by Aaron Hahn of Interior Dams

Mr. Hahn acknowledged the efforts of the Chief Administrative Officer and the Planner and Deputy Corporate Officer in working with him on this report.

A brief presentation of the highlights of the report was made by Mr. Hahn, which explained the 200-year flood plain mapping initiative and detailed his screening review of the City's flood risk mitigation efforts. Mr. Hahn explained how the information in his report may be used by the City. He recommended that the City adopt the new or updated maps into the relevant land use bylaws and that it proceed with developing an Integrated Flood Management Plan.
