- I understand that all hens must be provided with sufficient food, water, shelter, light, ventilation, veterinary care, and opportunities for essential behaviors such as scratching, dust-bathing, and roosting.
- I understand that the slaughtering or burial of backyard hens is prohibited on all residential zoned properties.

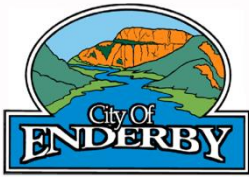

BACKYARD HENS LICENSE APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Please note that each of the following criteria will need to be satisfied, and confirmed via an on-site inspection by a City Official, prior to the issuance of a Backyard Hens License.

CRITERIA	YES	NO
Property zoned Residential Single-Family (R.1), Residential Single-Family (R.1-A), or Residential Two-Family (R.2)		
No more than five (5) backyard hens		
No roosters on-site		
Coop provided with an outdoor enclosure attached		
Coop and enclosure located entirely to the rear of the single-family dwelling and setback at least 3 m (9.84 feet) from rear or side lot line		
Area to the rear of the single-family dwelling is fully enclosed by solid fencing that is at least 1.8 m (5.9 feet) in height		
Height of coop and outdoor enclosure does not exceed 2 m (6.56 feet)		
Combined size of coop and outdoor enclosure does not exceed 10 m ² (107.6 square feet)		
Coop is fully enclosed and constructed to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Eliminate potential for infiltration from predators and rodents - Provide reasonable sound attenuation - Ensure proper ventilation and sufficient space for hens - Be accessible for persons to clean and maintain the coop 		
Coop provides at least one perch and one nest per hen		
Attached outdoor enclosure is enclosed on all sides and entirely covered from above to keep predators and rodents out, and prevent hens from escaping		
Feed for backyard hens stored in sealed containers and not located in an area accessible by pests, wildlife or domestic animals
