PORTFOLIO REPORTS

Councillor Case

Reported that planning for Funtastic is ongoing. There are 40 teams currently registered and organizers are working with Riverside RV Park to secure space for players to camp during the event.

Councillor Davyduke

Attended the graduation ceremony at A.L. Fortune Secondary and presented as a representative of Council. The event was very successful.

Work BC now has an app that can be used to sign up for services, look for jobs, and submit resumes. Work BC also hosts a monthly online job fair where employers can sign up to be present and connect with potential employees via Zoom.

Councillor Baird

Thanked the Enderby and District Arts Council for beautifying the empty lot at 617 Cliff Avenue. Suggested that a letter of thanks should be forwarded from Council.

Asked if it would be possible to use the other vacant lot on Cliff Avenue as a location for a food truck on days when most restaurants in town are closed.

Chief Administrative Officer responded that historically Council has not wanted to place a mobile vendor in a location where they would like to encourage construction. Suggested this lot could be used similar to the lot at 617 Cliff Avenue by the Enderby and District Arts Council.

Councillor Shishido

Attended Lumby Days and reported that the food vendors were excellent at the event. Also spoke with a regular attendee of car shows in the area who reported that Enderby's car shows for Canada Day and Friday Night Lights are a favourite of many people who regularly attend car shows.

Mayor McCune

Asked if it is possible to have the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure paint crosswalks earlier, in the spring, so that they can be used by students, instead of later in the summer.

Chief Administrative Officer responded that he will inquire with the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure.
