PORTFOLIO REPORTS

Councillor Case

Reported that Friday Night Lights went well.

Councillor Schreiner noted that this year was likely the best attendance the event has ever had and that there were approximately 200 cars that participated in the car show.

Councillor Davyduke

Thanked Councillor Baird for her work on Friday Night Lights and agreed that it was a great success. There were many car owners that came from other communities to attend the event.

Community Futures will be hosting a workshop for employers with a focus on recruitment and retention of staff on September 27, 2022. This workshop is being held in-person.

Councillor Shishido

Very impressed with the work done on Mill Avenue.

Reported that the food vendors at Friday Night Lights were great.

Councillor Schreiner

Attended Friday Night Lights.

Councillor Knust

Asked if some of the rocks along Waterwheel Street have been removed.

Chief Administrative Officer reported that the rocks have been removed but that there is still some weed-whacking to be done in the area.

Reported that the weeds along Bass Avenue have been removed and the area looks great.

Asked if there have been complaints from the owners of land adjacent to the rail trail corridor about weeds from the land taking over their properties.

Chief Administrative Officer responded that he is aware of one complaint but suspects that there are others, and suggested that the question be raised with the Planner during the regular meeting, as he is the manager of bylaw compliance and may have received more complaints.

Councillor Baird

Planning has begun for Halloween. Councillor Baird asked the rest of Council to think about what they might like to see done for Halloween. There will also be fireworks.

Noted that there were drones present during the Friday Night Lights event and that it would be nice if the City could use the footage for the proposed community promotional video.

Councillor Knust suggested that “best seats” for the burnout competition next year could be auctioned off for a cause.

Enderby Jewellers will be having an event on Cliff Avenue on October 1st to celebrate 75 years in business.

Will attend an upcoming budget meeting with the Okanagan Regional Library.
