This project replaces the old reservoir, which was at high risk of failure, with a new one that is built to modern design standards and sized for the current population and future growth. Its design will improve water quality, provide a more reliable supply to help with seasonal demands, and better protect our water system from hazards and risks.




Online Utility Payments

- 80-90% of FireSmart homes with non-combustible roofs & 10 metres of clearance will survive a major wildfire?


