Pre-Authorized Payment Plan

Auto-Renewal for 2027 & Beyond

If you were enrolled in the pre-payment plan for 2026, your plan will auto-renew for 2027. **You do not have to fill out a new form for 2027.**

REMINDER: If you signed up for the system calculated payment plan, a final payment of the remaining balance of your tax account as of June 15th will be withdrawn on July 1st. Manual payments made after June 15th will not be included in the calculation of your final payment.

Pre-Authorized Payment Plan for Utilities

Did you know you can pay your utilities automatically? You can sign up to have the balance of your utility account automatically withdrawn from your account on each utility due date.

The form to enroll in the program is available on the City website or can be picked up at City Hall. This program also auto-renews; if you were enrolled in 2026 your plan will continue automatically unless cancelled.

Any grants claimed after July 2nd are subject to a 10% penalty.

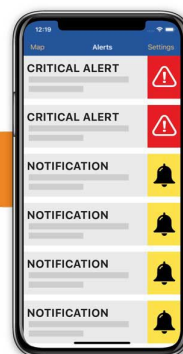


Wildfire season is right around the corner and we're here to help you take practical steps to improve your property's resilience to the threat of wildfire.

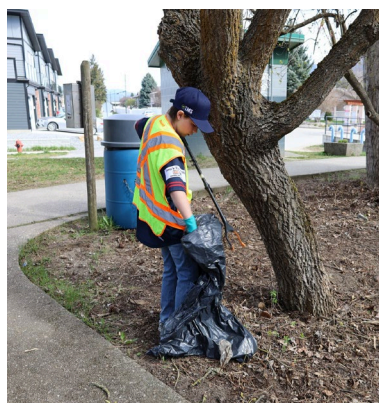

Volunteer Enderby

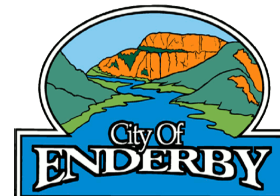
The City of Enderby is excited to announce the launch of Volunteer Enderby, a volunteer matchmaking website designed to connect local community groups with passionate community members.
